



Review of Key Projects at PRAGATI Meeting

- PM Modi chairs the 53rd PRAGATI meeting- Projects worth over ₹30,000 crore reviewed- Special focus on infrastructure development- Key directives on agriculture and cyber security

New Delhi, August 26, Trinet news : Prime Minister Narendra Modi chaired the 53rd PRAGATI meeting and reviewed the progress of key infrastructure projects across the country. He held comprehensive discussions with officials regarding the implementation of six major projects spanning the railway, road, and power sectors. Officials revealed that these projects are spread across nine states and have a total investment value exceeding ₹30,000 crore. The Prime Minister advised that infrastructure projects should be viewed from a holistic perspective rather than in isolation. He noted that every component of a project is interconnected; therefore, implementation must align with the project's overall objectives. He emphasized the need for special attention to the pace, quality, and coordination of the work. The Prime Minister directed that reforms continue at every stage of project implementation and urged central ministries and state governments to adopt a proactive approach. He advocated for identifying and resolving issues before they escalate, rather than merely reacting after problems arise. He further ordered the acceleration of work to ensure bene-



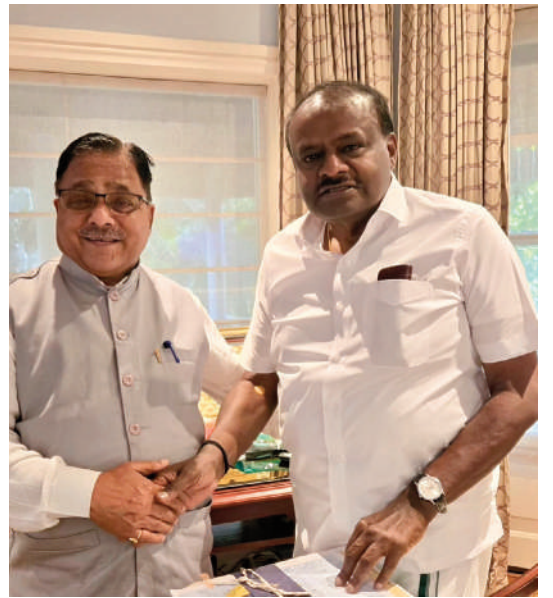

While reviewing the 'AgriStack' initiative for the agricultural sector, the Prime Minister suggested leveraging cutting-edge digital technologies—including artificial intelligence—to utilize agricultural data more effectively. He emphasized that technology is crucial for providing better services to farmers and enabling data-driven decision-making. The Prime Minister also expressed concern regarding cyber fraud and scams involving 'digital arrests.' He called for curbing such frauds through

public awareness, education on cybersecurity, training for officials, and coordination among relevant agencies, stressing the need to prioritize security in the digital world. Prime Minister Modi highlighted the pivotal role of the infrastructure sector in the nation's development, noting that advancements in transport, power, and digital sectors lay a strong foundation for economic growth. NDA Leaders Discuss Karnataka Politics

Need for Comprehensive Strategies for National Security

New Delhi, August 26 Trinet News: Union Home Minister Amit Shah participated in the valedictory session of the 9th National Security Strategies Conference and spoke on key issues concerning the country's security. He stated that India's foreign policies need to be shaped with due regard for global instability, energy security challenges, supply chain disruptions, religious extremism, and cyber-based disinformation campaigns. Amit Shah advised that potential threats to national security must be identified early and countered effectively. The Home Minister suggested that state governments incorporate the counter-terrorism strategy known as 'Prahar' into their daily security operations. He noted that misinformation and extremist propaganda spreading via cyber platforms are emerging as challenges to national security. He stated that security agencies need to be more vigilant in countering such threats and emphasized that raising public awareness is equally important. Amit Shah opined that, given the rapidly changing global economic and geopolitical landscape, national security strategies must be strengthened in line with the times. He suggested focusing specifically on areas such as energy security, the stability of supply chains, and the strengthening of international partnerships. The Home Minister noted that national security plays a pivotal role in achieving the goal of a 'Viksit Bharat' (Developed India). He stated that a strong foundation for the country's development can be laid through security, stability, and efficient governance. Representatives from security agencies and experts participating in the conference held extensive discussions on national security challenges and potential solutions.



High-Level Meeting Between Indian and Vietnamese Coast Guards



Chennai, August 26, Trinet News: The 7th high-level meeting between the Indian Coast Guard and the Vietnam Coast Guard was held in Chennai on August 25. The meeting took place under the framework of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on Coast Guard cooperation signed in 2015. The primary objective of the meeting was to further strengthen mutual cooperation in the fields of maritime security and safety. Indian Coast Guard Director General Paramesh Sivamani and Vietnam Coast Guard Deputy Commandant Major General Luong Dinh Hong co-chaired the meeting.

Representatives from both nations exchanged views on several key aspects of maritime security. Extensive discussions were held on topics such as maritime search and rescue operations, enforcement of maritime laws, control of illicit activities, and the safety of maritime routes. It was decided to implement measures for more effective mutual cooperation during maritime accidents and emergencies. Issues regarding marine pollution control and environmental protection were also accorded priority during the meeting. Both countries have decided to share technical expertise and experience

in addressing oil spills and pollution incidents at sea. They agreed to further expand cooperation in areas such as capacity building, training, joint exercises, and information sharing. Officials stated that this partnership would help effectively address maritime security challenges. It is reported that the meeting highlighted the crucial role of India-Vietnam cooperation in promoting peace, security, and stability in the Indian Ocean and Indo-Pacific regions. Officials added that this meeting would further strengthen the friendly ties between the two countries' coast guards.

Amaravati, August 26 Trinet News: A comprehensive review meeting was held regarding the progress of the new Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly building currently under construction in the capital, Amaravati. Man Arrested for Making Threats While Posing as a Journalist

- Action taken over allegations of extortion
- Case registered for assaulting a police constable
- Court orders 14-day remand



Srikakulam, August 26, Trinet News: Srikakulam Rural Police have arrested Korada Srinivasa Rao on charges of threatening people, engaging in high-handed behavior, and extorting money while claiming to be a journalist. Rural Circle Inspector Paidipu Naidu stated that the accused was produced before the court, and the Additional JMFC Court ordered a 14-day remand. Police revealed that the investigation showed the accused had threatened several individuals by introducing himself as a reporter for a news organization. According to the police, the accused allegedly targeted real estate businessmen, hostel operators, and Anganwadi staff, among others, to extort money through intimidation. The investigation further revealed that he had terrorized the public by claiming that no one in the district could question him and that neither politicians nor officials could take action against him. Police disclosed that several cases had been registered against the accused in the past as well. They noted that a case was previously registered against him in 2009 for threatening a hotel owner and demanding money. Additionally, another case has been registered against the accused on charges of threatening and behaving indecently towards the warden and staff of the Social Welfare School in Pedapadu.

Missing Fishermen Located



- Tense situation in the Bay of Bengal resolved
- Found safe off the West Bengal coast
- Government's search operations yield results

Amaravati, August 26, Trinet News: State Minister for Agriculture and Fisheries, Kinjarapu Atchannaidu, announced that the seven fishermen from Andhra Pradesh, who had gone missing in the Bay of Bengal earlier this month, have been located. Family members, relatives, and villagers breathed a sigh of relief

upon learning that they were safe. The state government expressed satisfaction with the success of the extensive search operations launched to locate the fishermen. The seven fishermen, hailing from Odalarevu in Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Konaseema district, had ventured into the sea for fishing on August 3. Although they were expected to return by August 12, their families grew anxious when no information was received from them. Subsequently, the matter was

brought to the government's attention, and officials immediately initiated search operations. According to Minister Atchannaidu, the boat carrying the fishermen developed a technical snag and drifted towards the West Bengal coast due to sea currents. After receiving information from officials there, AP authorities consulted the boat owner's family and confirmed that all the fishermen were safe. The Minister directed officials to take immediate steps to bring them back safely to their hometowns. The state government, in collaboration with the central government, conducted a massive search operation to locate the fishermen. The Indian Coast Guard, the Indian Navy, maritime security agencies, and Fisheries Department officials worked in close coordination. Intensifying the search efforts on Tuesday, 15 Coast Guard vessels and four helicopters were deployed. Simultaneously, the Eastern and North-Eastern Commands in Kolkata were alerted, and electronic surveillance was maintained under the supervision of the Marine Rescue Coordination Centre. Given the gravity of the situation, maritime authorities in neighboring Bangladesh and Myanmar were also in-

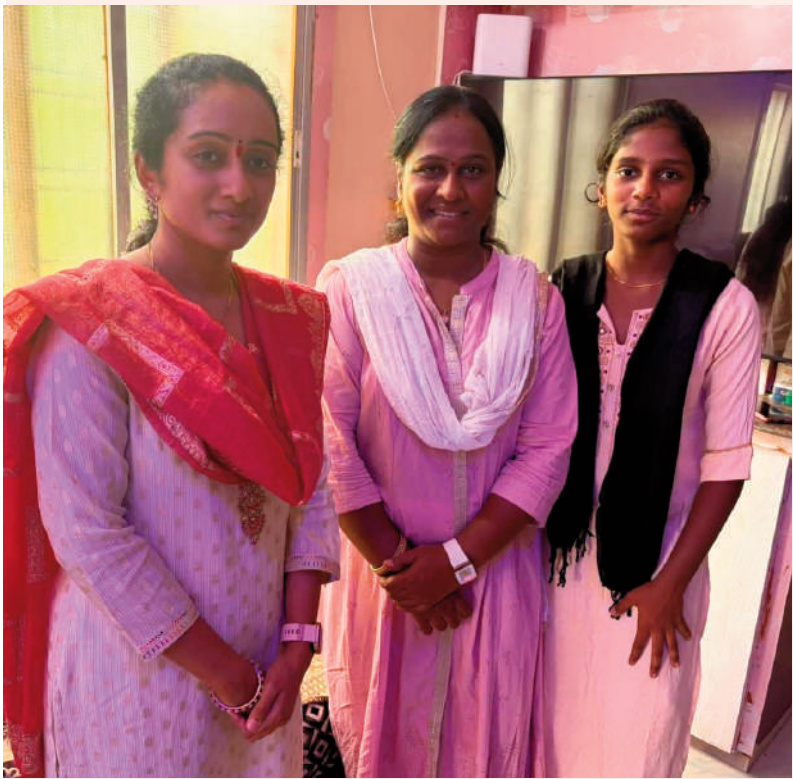
Success Comes Through Hard Work: Madhavi Secures Three Posts in Mega DSC

Horrific Road Accident Claims Five Lives

Tri Net News – August 26 : A horrific road accident took place near Dwarakunta in Kodad Mandal of Suryapet district. A private travel bus reportedly rammed into a stationary container, resulting in the deaths of five passengers on the spot. Around 20 others sustained serious injuries. The private travel bus was reportedly traveling from Hyderabad towards Eluru when it collided heavily with the container that was parked near Dwarakunta. The impact was so severe that the front portion of the bus was completely mangled. Several passengers were trapped inside the damaged bus, leading to heart-breaking scenes at the accident



spot. Immediately after the accident, the trapped passengers cried for help. Local residents rushed to the spot and started rescue operations. After receiving information, police and fire department personnel reached the scene and worked to rescue those trapped inside the

bus. The injured passengers were rushed to nearby hospitals for emergency treatment. According to doctors, the condition of two of the injured passengers is said to be critical. There are concerns that the death toll could rise if the condition of the critically injured passengers deteriorates. The exact cause of the accident is yet to be established. Police have launched an investigation to determine whether over-speeding, negligent driving, or other factors were responsible for the collision. Police officials are also working to identify the deceased passengers and inform their families. Further details are expected as the investigation progresses.

Gold Prices See a Slight Decline in Hyderabad



Tri Net News August 26 : 2026 Gold prices in Hyderabad have witnessed a slight decline. With gold prices fluctuating over the past few days due to developments in international markets, a modest fall in the price of the precious metal has been recorded recently. The decline has provided some relief to consumers planning to purchase gold. International market conditions, the value of the US dollar, expectations regarding interest rates, and global economic developments are among the major factors influencing gold prices. Domestically, the exchange rate of the Indian rupee, import duties, and local demand also play an important role in determining gold prices. Market sources advise gold buyers to keep track of the latest price movements and make purchasing decisions according to their individual requirements and financial considerations.

AI services should not be restricted to large farmers and corporate organizations; they must reach every farmer. True progress in agriculture will be possible only when farmers' traditional knowledge and experience are combined with modern technology. The agriculture of future India needs to integrate traditional knowledge with modern technological advancements. By connecting Artificial Intelligence with agriculture, it may be possible to achieve higher yields at lower costs, reduce crop losses, and increase farmers' incomes. The suggestion made by the Union Agriculture Minister could provide an important direction for the future of Indian agriculture. Just as the farmer has traditionally held a plow in his hands, in today's modern era, he should also have access to technological knowledge and tools. Integrating AI with agriculture can potentially pave the way for greater security, improved productivity, reduced losses, and better incomes for Indian farmers. AP Minister Calls for Strict Punishment for Sadik

"Those who commit wrongdoing should not be allowed to escape the law"

If the investigation establishes the involvement of any individual, appropriate legal action should be taken based on the person's role and the evidence available, he said.The minister stated that protecting public confidence in the justice system is an important responsibility of the government. At the same time, he cautioned against spreading speculation or unverified allegations before all the facts of the incident are established. He also directed the authorities to expedite steps to ensure justice for those affected.The minister said that strict action against those found responsible for offenses is necessary to strengthen public confidence in the rule of law. Once wrongdoing is established, the legal process should be pursued firmly so that those responsible face appropriate punishment, he said.The minister's statement that Sadik should be "strictly punished" has now become a subject of discussion in political and public circles. Attention is focused on the outcome of the investigation and the further action that may follow once the facts are fully established.The minister made it clear that no one is above the law and that strict legal action will follow if wrongdoing is proven through due process.

Nepal Devastated by Severe Flash Floods

Bhotekoshi River Turns Fierce Villages, Roads and Bridges Washed Away



Trinet News : 26th August 2026Kathmandu: Massive Destruction After Sudden Flash FloodsNepal has been hit by severe flash floods, causing widespread destruction in several mountainous areas. The Bhotekoshi River, near the Nepal-China border, suddenly swelled and turned extremely dangerous, sweeping through settlements and damaging houses, vehicles, roads, bridges and power infrastructure.According to the latest reports, at least nine people have died, while several others are reported missing. The death toll could rise as rescue and search operations continue.The Rasuwa district, particularly areas around Syaphrubesi and Timure, have been badly affected. Authorities have issued warnings to people living near riverbanks and low-lying areas and have begun efforts to move residents to safer locations.Hundreds Reported MissingA large number of people are believed to be missing following the floods. Reports indicate that several tourists and foreign nationals may also be among those affected. Information regarding the exact number of missing persons is still being verified by the authorities.Some reports have also suggested that more than 100 Indians may be missing. However, these figures are subject to verification, and the numbers may change as rescue teams collect more information.Roads and Bridges Severely DamagedThe powerful floodwaters have destroyed or severely damaged several bridges and roads. In some locations, bridges have been completely swept away, disrupting transportation and isolating affected communities.Mud, rocks, fallen trees and debris have blocked roads, making it difficult for rescue teams to reach some of the affected areas. The strong river currents have also created dangerous conditions for rescue operations.Hydropower Projects AffectedNepal's important hydropower sector has also suffered significant damage. Several facilities connected with electricity generation and transmission have reportedly been affected.The damage is particularly concerning because hydropower is an important part of Nepal's economy and energy infrastructure. Restoring damaged power projects and related infrastructure is expected to be a major challenge for the government.Army and Security Forces Lead Rescue OperationsThe Nepal Army, police and Armed Police Force have been deployed for rescue and relief operations. Helicopters are being used to search for missing people and reach areas that have become inaccessible by road.Rescue teams are working to evacuate stranded residents, provide food and emergency supplies and search for people reported missing.However, difficult mountainous terrain, damaged roads, strong river currents and continuing weather-related risks are creating major challenges for rescue personnel.Possible Causes of the Flash FloodAuthorities are still investigating the exact cause of the sudden flooding. Preliminary assessments suggest that landslides, falling rocks or other blockages in the mountainous region may have temporarily obstructed the river before a large volume of water was suddenly released.Experts have repeatedly warned that Himalayan regions are increasingly vulnerable to extreme weather events, including heavy rainfall, rapid snow and ice melt, landslides and glacial-related hazards.The latest disaster has once again highlighted the importance of strengthening early-warning systems and disaster preparedness in mountainous regions.Serious Impact on the China BorderThe disaster has also affected areas on the Chinese side of the border. Reports indicate that the Gyirong area of Tibet has experienced flooding and landslides, with infrastructure and border-related facilities affected.The disaster has disrupted transportation and trade routes between Nepal and China, adding to the economic impact of the floods.Authorities on High AlertOfficials have warned communities living along river systems to remain alert and avoid approaching rivers. People in vulnerable areas have been advised to follow instructions from local authorities and move to safer locations whenever necessary.Nepal experiences heavy rainfall and landslides during the monsoon season, which generally continues from June through September. However, the scale and suddenness of the latest flash floods have caused serious concern.Rehabilitation Will Be a Major ChallengeThe immediate priority is to rescue people who are stranded, locate those who are missing and provide emergency assistance to affected families. Once the rescue phase is completed, the government will face the major task of rebuilding damaged roads, bridges, houses, electricity infrastructure and other public facilities.Coordination between government agencies, security forces and local administrations will be essential for effective relief operations.Natural disasters cannot always be prevented

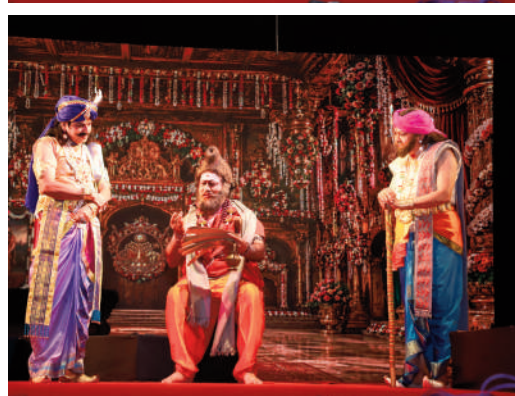
